#### **Proposal Sections:**

#### 1) Detailed Project Description:

Provide a one-page description of your research proposal. The description should include research methodology and anticipated research contribution and impact. Be sure to describe the holdings of the research institution you will be consulting and how these will contribute to your project.

#### 2) Budget Justification:

Provide a budget justification for the funds being requested. Please advise in your budget the dollar amount and rough exchange values for trips abroad. <u>Also make sure to specify the proposed dates of your trip.</u>

#### 3) Publication History:

Applicants should attach their publication history, if it is applicable to this grant. Conferences may also be listed.

#### 4) Research Grant History for the Past Five Years:

Applicants should provide a list of all research grants received over the course of their graduate career. Applicants should also include a list of all grants that have been submitted and whose competition results are not yet known.

### **Application Deadline:**

Your completed application must be received by **4:00 pm** on **15**<sup>th</sup> **April**. Applicants should submit one signed original.
